Dear Mr Man.

Thank you for your request for access to documents, which the EEAS has examined in the framework of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001<sup>1</sup>.

First of all, we would like to inform you that the complete agenda of the Head of the EU Delegation to Israel is not a public document. Following your request, we have therefore examined his appointment calendar pursuant to the rules of the Regulation.

We concluded that partial access can be given to you and I am therefore pleased to forward to you the document in attachment to this letter.

In the attached calendar redactions have been made in order to respect the provisions on data protection, i.e. non-disclosure of names of staff members and of third parties, email addresses, physical addresses, telephone numbers and other personal data pursuant to Art 4(1)(b) of the Regulation. For the same reason, we have also redacted any mention of private appointments or private diary entries concerning Mr Giaufret or other persons from his family, as well as travel during his holidays.

We are of the opinion that, by doing so, the appropriate balance has been found between the right to data protection (in particular the fact that there should be "no reason to assume that the data subject's legitimate interests might be prejudiced") and the public interests of transparency.
